



THE KITCHEN BIN ALTERNATIVE

Many a Hollywood movie has perpetuated the idea that food waste disposers contain scary spinning blades like a blender, but this is simply not the case. Here is the inside of an Evolution 100 food waste disposer and, as you can see, there are no blades.

The Evolution 100 features two lugs that rotate on a spinning plate. The lugs act like two little hammers breaking the food down until it is small enough to fit through the small holes on the outside grind ring. Food is then washed through the existing plumbing to a waste water treatment plant for processing.

People all over the globe are concerned about the environment. While there's no single solution for managing and getting rid of the
